

Balance Spring Replacment

- 1. With quill at full up position, apply quill lock
- 2. Remove screw A, Hub B, and key C
- 3. Remove screws D and allow the clock spring assembly to slowly rotate and relieve the spring tension.
- 4. Lift the end of the spring from the pin on the pinion shaft.
- 5. Rotate and remove the clock spring.
- 6. Insert the new clock spring assembly until the spring locates the pin in the pinion shaft and snaps into place.
- 7. Rotate the assembly 2-1/2 turns.



Balance Spring Replacment

- 1. With quill at full up position, apply quill lock
- 2. Remove screw A, Hub B, and key C
- 3. Remove screws D and allow the clock spring assembly to slowly rotate and relieve the spring tension.
- 4. Lift the end of the spring from the pin on the pinion shaft.
- 5. Rotate and remove the clock spring.
- 6. Insert the new clock spring assembly until the spring locates the pin in the pinion shaft and snaps into place.



7. Rotate the assembly 2-1/2 turns.
