

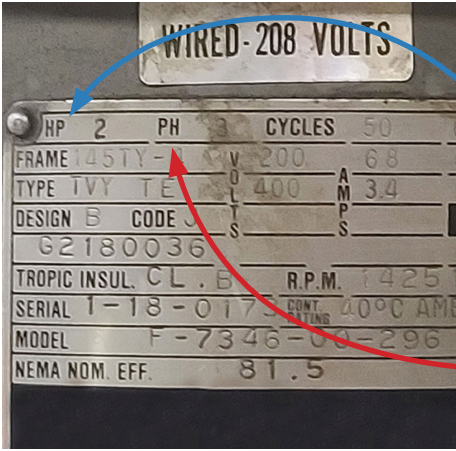

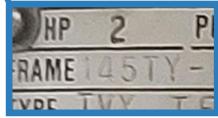
MACHINE DO I HAVE?

In order to determine your Bridgeport Machine type, we need to start with the motor. Use the diagram below to help you locate the HP of your Bridgeport Machine Motor.

To the left there is an example of a Bridgeport Plate which contains the info we need in order to determine your machine's motor HP.



Make sure you are looking at the "HP"



Do NOT use the "PH" section.

Once you have found your machine's motor HP - you can move on to the next step.

What is the HP of your Motor?

1 hp

Is your table size one of the following:
32" / 36" / 42" / 48"

YES

You have a:
Series I Bridgeport Machine with a Step Pulley Head

NO

You may have a Bridgeport Head on a Non-Bridgeport Body.
Some of our head parts may not fit your machine.

1.5 hp

Is your table size one of the following:
32" / 36" / 42" / 48"

YES

You have a:
Series I Bridgeport Machine with 1 - 1/2 HP Variable Speed Head

NO

You may have a Bridgeport Head on a Non-Bridgeport Body.
Some of our head parts may not fit your machine.

2 hp

Is your table size one of the following:
32" / 36" / 42" / 48"

YES

You have a:
*** Series I Bridgeport Machine with 2 HP Variable Speed Head**

NO

Is your table size one of the following:
54" / 58"

YES

You have a:
Series II Bridgeport Machine with 2 HP Motor

NO

You may have a Bridgeport Head on a Non-Bridgeport Body.
Some of our head parts may not fit your machine.

3 hp

You do not have a Bridgeport Machine or yours was modified. **Some of our head parts may not fit your machine.**

4 hp

Is your table size one of the following:
54" / 58"

YES

You have a:
Series II Bridgeport Machine with 4 HP Head

NO

You may have a Bridgeport Head on a Non-Bridgeport Body.
Some of our head parts may not fit your machine.

5 hp

You do not have a Bridgeport Machine or yours was modified. **Some of our head parts may not fit your machine.**

*** Wait! My machine says Series II but you are telling me I have a Series I?**
Yes, in the late 90's Bridgeport put Series II on many of their Series I machines. **Trust us - it's a Series I**
